Foundation Scripture

Ephesians 6:12-13 (KJV)

"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

Ephesians 6:12-13 reveals a profound spiritual truth: the challenges, conflicts, and disturbances that affect our lives, families, and homes often have a spiritual dimension.

The apostle Paul emphasizes that our struggle is not merely against people or circumstances: "flesh and blood"; but against spiritual forces of evil.

These forces are described as "principalities," "powers," "rulers of the darkness of this world," and "spiritual wickedness in high places," highlighting that they operate strategically and are intent on influencing lives and environments for destruction.

The context of this verse is Paul's instruction to believers on how to live victorious lives amid spiritual opposition.

The “whole armour of God” is the believer’s divine protection and includes faith, truth, righteousness, the gospel of peace, salvation, and the Word of God, all reinforced by prayer.

This armour equips Christians to resist, confront, and prevent evil influences from gaining access into their personal spaces, including their homes.

In Acts 21:8-9, we read about Philip the evangelist, who had seven daughters who were prophetesses. Imagine daughters in one family walking in spiritual gifts and prophetic ministry!

This did not happen by accident; it happened because the spiritual atmosphere in that home was conducive to God's presence.

Lessons for you:

When Christ is Lord of your home, spiritual gifts can manifest.

Every child is positioned for destiny, not for spiritual void.

6. What Declaring His Lordship Covers

When you declare Christ as Lord, you are declaring His authority over:

The traits of every person in your home (their spiritual identity).

Chapter Four

Compromise by either or both partners in a home is one of the easiest ways Satan and his demons gain access into your life and family.

The Bible teaches us that the choices of both spouses can either protect or expose the household to spiritual attacks, because both spouses are spiritual gates to their home and children.

When either or both partners begin to indulge in activities such as:

Drugs and substance abuse

Extramarital affairs

Wrong associations and ungodly friendships

Clubbing and immoral entertainment

Gambling and frequenting casinos

...they unwittingly open the gates of their home to wicked spirits, who then enter to destroy relationships, peace, and prosperity.

Even if you are unmarried, the principle still applies: your personal life is a hedge of protection around you.

The moment you compromise your righteous stance, the hedge is broken.

The enemy then has unhindered access to your life, making shipwreck of your peace, joy, and future.

The Word of God warns us about this reality:

“He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind; and the fool shall be servant to the wise of heart.” – Proverbs 11:29

“He that forsaketh the law of the father shall be hated of his children: but he that keepeth instruction shall be beloved.” – Proverbs 13:1

When you live a clean and decent life, there is a spiritual hedge around you (Job 1:10).

This hedge wards off demonic intruders and scavengers.

But once the hedge is broken by compromise, these forces gain entry and begin to bite like serpents, bringing deceit, confusion, and destruction.

The Bible clearly states:

“He that breaketh a hedge, a serpent shall bite him.” –
Ecclesiastes 10:8

Many believers have experienced the consequences of compromise, thinking they can do something wrong, ask God for forgiveness, and everything will be fine.

Yes, God is faithful to forgive (1 John 1:9), but forgiveness does not automatically expel the spirits that have entered through disobedience or compromise.

These spirits must be dealt with through repentance, prayer, and re-establishing spiritual authority in your life.

Guarding Against Compromise

The most effective way to protect your home is prevention. Never give the devil an opportunity in the first place.

Do not compromise your righteousness for fleeting pleasure, convenience, or peer pressure.

Your lifestyle and choices directly influence the spiritual climate of your home.

Consider the examples of faithful servants in Scripture:

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refused to bow to the king's image, even under threat of death (Daniel 3:16–18).

Their uncompromising stance preserved their integrity and drew God's mighty hand of protection.

Daniel remained steadfast in prayer, even when it was forbidden by law, and God preserved him (Daniel 6:10–23).

Joseph refused the advances of Potiphar's wife, knowing that yielding would compromise his destiny and invite spiritual attack (Genesis 39:7–12).

Naboth stood firm against the king's unjust demand for his vineyard, refusing compromise at the expense of his inheritance (1 Kings 21:3).

These examples show that a life of uncompromising righteousness is not only protective but also positions you to receive God's blessings and favor.

Practical Steps to Protect Your Home

Establish Your Personal Hedge: Live a life of integrity, prayer, and obedience.

Avoid ungodly associations and behaviors.

Monitor Household Activities: If you are married, make sure both partners are aligned in godly living.

Teach children and household members the importance of purity and holiness.

The Scripture reminds us:

“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” – James 4:7

Chapter Five

Overlooking, Over-Petting, and Over-Pampering: The Hidden Open Doors for Evil

One of the most dangerous spiritual pitfalls in homes today is overlooking, over-petting, and over-pampering; especially of your children.

This is not just a cultural habit; it is a spiritual vulnerability that can create open doors for evil influences to enter your household.

Overlooking is when you ignore attitudes, character flaws, lifestyles, desires, and behaviors that are clearly contrary to God's Word.

Over-petting and over-pampering happen when you excessively indulge your spouse or children, giving them freedom to act and live in ways that drift from God's principles, even when you are fully aware of it.

Ask yourself:

How often do I excuse behaviors in my family that contradict Scripture?

How often do I prioritize their comfort over God's commands?

This is exactly what happened in the days of the priest Eli.

His sons, Hophni and Phinehas, were corrupt; they abused their priestly position, took the best portions of the offerings by force, and treated God's covenant lightly (1 Samuel 2:12-17).

Eli saw their behavior and overlooked it, saying only:

“Why do you do such things?” (1 Samuel 2:23).

He did not take the authority given him by God to correct them decisively.

The tragic end? Both sons died on the same day, and the glory of Israel was humiliated (1 Samuel 4:11).

Eli's household was completely broken because of his failure to uphold God's standard over his love for his children.

This is a spiritual lesson for every parent and leader: when God's Word is not prioritized over familial affection, consequences are devastating.

Similarly, Achan and his entire family experienced total destruction because of disobedience and indulgence.

God commanded that no one should take the devoted things from Jericho, yet Achan stole items for himself (Joshua 6:18-19, 24).

His sin, though personal, opened the door for God's judgment to fall on his entire family and clan.

This shows that neglecting God's standard; even in what seems private or personal, can have far-reaching consequences.

The Standard of God's Word
